Introduction

Ethiopia is a land of cultural diversity in which its people together live with harmony, well known for affluent history and natural attractions in the world. It is one of the very few African states maintained independence. Addis Ababa, the capital of Ethiopia founded in1886. Currently, it recognized as the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia (FDRE) with parliamentary form of government. The first modern Master plan for Addis Ababa, a metropolitan city was conceived shortly after the Italian incursion of the country in 1936. There is a rapid population and economic growth as well as high rural-urban migration which forced for urban growth. The pace of urban growth is expected to be accelerating in the next decades. However, Ethiopia remains one of the least urbanized countries in Africa and almost 20 percent of its population resides in urban area.

The country is situated in the Horn of Africa and astronomically located 3°N to 15°N and 33°E to 48°E. It is also bordered to the north by Eritrea, to the west by the Sudan, to the east by Djibouti and Somalia and to the south by Kenya. It covers an area of 1,100,000 square kilometers and its rates of urbanization is the fastest one in Africa. According to the 1999 E, C the national census officially reveled by CSA, the total population was about 87.9 million. This made the second most populous and the tenth largest African nation next to Nigeria.
